Game quests arrive at 4:20 a.m. every morning. The first task is to cut off a hand and draw a picture of a whale on it, and the last task is to commit suicide. Apparently, a 14-15-year-old teenager,

who did not commit suicide, is forced to commit suicide by intimidation. Philip Liss, who was believed to be the leader of the game group, was mentally ill and was sentenced to 1 year in prison for the game he created. He gathered more than 300 thousand subscribers to his group. The reason why the group is called blue whale is because whales throw themselves ashore due to depression. This game has claimed the lives of more than 230 teenagers.

The main reason for the above cases is the lack of information culture among young people. On the other hand, it is certainly impossible to enumerate the useful aspects of the Internet.
