ABSTRACT

Also, during the years of independence, 3425 teachers and psychologists in the public education system of the republic have been awarded various state awards and titles for outstanding achievements in pedagogical activities and selfless work. Six of them were awarded the title of "Hero of Uzbekistan", 302 - "People's Teacher of the Republic of Uzbekistan" and 319 - "Honored Worker of Public Education of Uzbekistan", 101 21 were awarded the Order of El-Yurt Hurmati, 21 were awarded the Order of Fidokorona Hizmatlari Uchun, and 1229 were awarded the Shuhrat Medal. The national model, highlighted in the "National Program of Personnel Training", takes into account the national and territorial features of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the image of a cadre (specialist) - a well-rounded person and a mature specialist, trained on the basis of advanced science, engineering
