Annotatsiya

Mazkur maqolada til o'rganishda motivatsiyaning ahamiyati va uning o'quvchilarning akademik muvaffaqiyati hamda tilni o'zlashtirish jarayoniga ta'siri tahlil qilinadi. Tadqiqotda ichki va tashqi motivatsiya turlari hamda ularning til ko'nikmalarini rivojlantirishdagi o'rni o'rganilgan. Shuningdek, psixologik omillar, o'quvchilarning darsdagi faolligi, sinf muhiti, o'qituvchi yordami va
