

## THE ROLE OF AUTHENTIC MATERIALS IN LANGUAGE LEARNING

### Literature review

Richards (2001) emphasizes that authentic materials help bridge the gap between classroom learning and real-world communication.<sup>3</sup> Similarly, Tomlinson (2012) highlights that authentic input can increase learner motivation and encourage meaningful interaction with language.<sup>4</sup>

Research has also shown that authentic materials support the development of intercultural competence by introducing learners to different cultural perspectives and communication styles. This aspect is particularly important in English language teaching, where successful communication often requires both linguistic and cultural understanding.

### **Methodology**

This study is based on a qualitative analysis of previous research related to authentic materials in language learning. Relevant books, journal articles, and educational reports were examined to identify the advantages, limitations, and pedagogical implications of authentic materials in foreign language classrooms.<sup>5</sup> Additionally, examples of authentic materials commonly used in English language teaching, such as newspaper articles, podcasts, videos, social media content, and websites, were analyzed to determine their educational value and practical application.

### **Results and Discussion**

Third, authentic materials support the development of all four language skills. Reading authentic articles improves comprehension and vocabulary acquisition, while listening to podcasts and videos enhances listening skills and pronunciation awareness. Furthermore,
