A characteristic feature is leather tassels, moccasins (moccasins), saddle shoes (oxfords), saddle oxford (oxfords), (oxfords), sandals, slides (boots with a very low heel that cover only the front of the foot), slingbacks (shoes with an open heel and a thin strip around the ankle), slippers), espadrilles (espadrilles - summer shoes, the upper part of which is made of canvas, and the sole is made of woven rope), flip-flops, sneakers (sneakers), trainers (sneakers), hip boots (waterproof boots up to the hips), topboots (tall boots with a bright leather strip on top), brogues (brogues - a style of shoes with perforations made on the entire surface of the boot), derby (derby - open lace boots).
